

Timeline for Transition and Duration of Remote Learning The Jeffco Public Schools, in coordination with Jeffco Public Health, has made the decision to transition secondary schools to 100% remote learning. Our current hybrid and remote learning models were designed to support a seamless transition in and out of remote learning. Conifer plans to transition into full remote learning beginning on Monday, November 16, 2020 and for the duration of the Fall Semester (Tuesday, December 22, 2020). All Conifer students should plan to join their Green Day class remotely on Monday, November 16, 2020.

The Bell Schedule during 100% Remote Learning is shown below. All students, including hybrid students and remote students, will now attend all their classes synchronously online Monday through Thursday (Green, Green, Silver, Silver) and asynchronously on Fridays.

Learning Management System (LMS)

Teachers will continue to utilize and update Google Classroom with lesson resources and class assignments. Google Classroom will also continue to be the place to find the Attendance Assignment required on Asynchronous Friday's for each class. If for any reason, your student is having difficulties accessing their teacher's Google Classroom, please have them reach out to the teacher directly.

Attendance: Synchronous

Students will be counted present and <u>on-time</u> if they log into their teacher's Zoom classroom at the time their class is scheduled to begin and engage in the lesson until the teacher dismisses class or individual students. Remember, students must have their camera on, be visible, and engage to be counted present.

Attendance: Asynchronous	Students will be counted present if they complete the attendance quiz or attendance assignment posted on their teacher's Google Classroom by 2:00 p.m. on an asynchronous day (typically Fridays).	
Student Support: Special Education	As we transition to remote learning, our Special Education team will work with the families of students with IEPs on an individual basis regarding educational services. If you have a specific question about your student's IEP and remote learning, please contact their Special Education service provider.	
Student Support:	We will continue to support students to the best of our abilities while adhering to district health guidelines. If your student is struggling, please reach out to their teacher first! Teacher office hours on Fridays and Seminar (Green Days 7:45 - 9:15 am) provide a valuable time to students to connect with teachers for reteaching and assignment clarification. Students have access to a link for all Seminar Google Meets.	
Student Support: Additional Student Supports	Fridays are designated for student support and asynchronous learning. Conifer plans to expand our Friday in-person intervention seminars to Monday through Fridays. If your student is struggling and needs additional support or you wish to apply for a 1-on-1 peer mentor tutor, please contact Assistant Principal Greg Manier at Gregory.Manier@jeffco.k12.co.us.
